

Adults with Cochlear Implants Needed for a Listening Study

The Speech Research Laboratory at the Nemours/Alfred I. duPont Hospital for Children is conducting a research study to evaluate the quality of synthetic speech for possible use in aural rehabilitation software for cochlear implant recipients. Participants will listen to samples of synthetic speech and type what they hear on a computer. Participants must be at least 18 years old and have bilateral cochlear implants or a unilateral implant with non-functional hearing in the contralateral ear. All participants must be native speakers of American English. Participants will be paid \$25.00 for one 1-hour session.
